

## 🌿 SUMMER EDEMA FIX — CHEAT SHEET

Indian Container Tomato, Capsicum & Balsam • Day 17 of the 30-Day Summer Gardening Challenge

**⚠️ SUMMER EDEMA IS NOT A DISEASE OR PEST — IT IS A HYDRAULIC PRESSURE INJURY. NO SPRAY HAS ANY EFFECT.**

### WHAT HAPPENS INSIDE THE LEAF:

Pre-monsoon humidity above 65% overnight → stomata close. But roots in warm 28–35°C soil keep pushing water at full rate. Turgor pressure exceeds cell wall capacity → cell wall ruptures → permanent corky bump.

### WHAT DOES NOT WORK:

- X Copper oxychloride (fungicide — no organism to kill)
- X Systemic fungicide (same reason — ruptured cells, not fungal)
- X Neem oil spray (no pest, no pathogen present)

### THE MECHANISM — WHY APRIL–MAY:

EVENING WATERING  
+ 65%+ HUMIDITY  
Soil max-wet at night.  
Stomata closing. Roots  
active 28–35°C.  
✗ EDEMA BY MORNING

MORNING WATERING  
SAME HUMIDITY  
Stomata fully open. Water  
moves efficiently all day.  
✓ NO EDEMA

*Indian pre-monsoon nights (28–35°C): roots stay metabolically ACTIVE all night. Western gardens: nights cool to 12–18°C, roots slow. This is why edema is an Indian outdoor problem that no guide warns about.*

### 🌿 WATERING TIME DATA — APRIL TO JUNE 2023, MADANAPALLE (ORIGINAL DATA)

#### 6 PLANTS, SAME HUMIDITY, ONE VARIABLE:

Balsam, Evening 7PM, 76% humidity:	EDEMA ✗
Balsam, Morning 6:30AM, 76%:	No edema ✓
Tomato, Evening 7PM, 71%:	EDEMA ✗
Tomato, Morning 7AM, 71%:	No edema ✓
Capsicum, Evening 7:30PM, near wall, 68%:	EDEMA ✗

#### TWO VARIABLES DETERMINE RISK:

##### 1. WATERING TIME

Evening + humidity above 65% = edema  
Morning = zero edema under same humidity

##### 2. TERRACE POSITION

Near parapet wall = 8–12% more local humidity  
Open central terrace = same humidity as ambient  
Above 75%: position matters less

Capsicum, Evening 7:30PM, open terrace,  
68%:

None  
✓

*65-70% overnight humidity + evening watering = edema risk active.*

*Above 75%: morning watering alone may not prevent balsam edema.*


*Below 60%: standard evening watering acceptable.*

## THE 4-QUESTION DIAGNOSTIC TEST + SUMMER EDEMA vs SIMILAR LEAF PROBLEMS

4-QUESTION DIAGNOSTIC (ALL FOUR YES = SUMMER EDEMA  NO SPRAY NEEDED):

| ① Did bumps appear overnight, all mature leaves at once? (not progressive spread) | ③ Was there overnight humidity above 65% in the 1-3 days before? |
| ② Is new growth at the growing tip completely smooth?                             | ④ Was the primary watering in the evening during that period?    |

Symptom	Wipes Off?	New Growth	Weather Link	Diagnosis
Dry corky bumps, leaf underside	No	Smooth, clean	Post-humid evening watering	Summer edema
White dusty patches, upper surface	Partially	Also affected	Hot dry poor airflow	Powdery mildew (D12)
Hard bumps along veins	No	Distorted	Not correlated	Pest/viral gall
Silvery stippling, sheen	No	Also stippled	Hot dry weather	Spider mite (D10)
Distorted, cupped new growth	No	Severely distorted	Not correlated	Thrips / aphid

✓ *DAMP CLOTH TEST: Wipe bumps  edema stays, powdery mildew transfers. If bumps stay fixed and new growth is smooth = edema confirmed. Change watering time only.*

## PRE-MONSOON EDEMA RISK BY CITY — APRIL-MAY OVERNIGHT CONDITIONS

City	Overnight Temp	Pre-Monsoon Humidity	Evening Risk	Morning Risk
Bangalore	22–27°C	65–78%	Moderate	Low
Mumbai	28–33°C	75–90%	Very High	Moderate
Hyderabad	26–32°C	65–80%	High	Low
Chennai	29–34°C	72–88%	Very High	Moderate
Madanapalle	26–32°C	64–78%	High	Low
Delhi	28–36°C	55–72%	Moderate–High	Low
Ahmedabad	30–38°C	52–68%	Moderate	Low

*Threshold for morning-watering switch: 2 consecutive nights above 65% humidity. Mumbai/Chennai gardeners: consider morning watering mandatory from April 1st onward.*

## 🌿 SUMMER EDEMA FIX — PAGE 2: MORNING WATERING + TERRACE POSITIONING

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Morning Watering Steps • Volume Reduction • Terrace Position • Rajan Benchmark • Managing Leaves

### 🌿 MORNING WATERING PROTOCOL — THE FREE PRIMARY FIX

#### WATERING WINDOW: 6:30–8:00 AM ONLY

Stomata fully open in morning: warm, bright, lower humidity. Water moves efficiently. No overnight pressure buildup possible.

#### STEPS:

1. Shift ALL primary watering to before 8 AM
2. Check overnight humidity each morning (ThermoPro TP49)
3. At 2+ nights above 65%: morning-only, reduce volume 25–35%
4. Use 2-inch finger test before watering 📍 skip if still moist
5. For balsam: morning-only from April 1st regardless of humidity
6. At 75%+: morning watering may still not protect balsam 📍 improve air circulation too

#### 📌 DO NOT:

Apply any spray to bumps (no organism) • Remove affected leaves (still photosynthesising) • Reduce fertiliser (unrelated to pressure) • Expect existing bumps to disappear (permanent)

#### VOLUME ADJUSTMENT GUIDE:

Overnight Humidity	Volume Adjustment	Watering Time
Below 60%	Standard volume	Morning or evening OK
60–65%	Standard, monitor balsam	Morning preferred
65–75% (2+ nights)	Reduce 25–35%	Morning ONLY
Above 75%	Reduce 35–40%, finger test first	Morning ONLY + improve spacing

*A 12-inch terracotta needing 1.5L in dry April heat needs ~1L during 70% humidity events. Soil retains moisture longer in high humidity.*

**BALSAM RULE:** Morning-only from April 1st.

Shows edema at 60–65% before any other species.

Natural early warning indicator — if balsam shows bumps, check tomato and capsicum immediately.

## 🌿 TERRACE POSITIONING — THE HUMIDITY POCKET FIX

### WHY POSITION MATTERS:

Indian terraces enclosed on 3 sides by parapet walls trap plant transpiration, creating local humidity 8–12% above ambient at leaf level.

68% ambient near open terrace = 76–80% local against wall = borderline becomes edema-triggering.

### THREE FREE CHANGES:

Action	Effect
Move containers 40–50 cm from walls	Reduces trapped humidity
Space pots 25–30 cm apart	Reduces inter-pot humidity +5–8%
Elevate balsam on brick or stand	Improves airflow beneath pot

**⚠️ WARNING:** Containers against south/west parapet wall + evening watering during pre-monsoon = the worst possible edema combination. Move susceptible species inward before humidity events arrive.

*Do not mist leaves during humidity above 65% — increases local humidity further, worsens edema risk.*

## 🌿 MANAGING AFFECTED LEAVES — WHAT TO KEEP, WHAT TO REMOVE

EXISTING BUMPS ARE PERMANENT.

## 🌿 RAJAN — CHENNAI BENCHMARK

5TH FLOOR EAST TERRACE, CAPSICUM, 2 CONSECUTIVE APRIL SEASONS

Two seasons, same bumps, same mystery.

✗ Year 1: Copper spray (nursery diagnosis — fungal)

✗ Year 2: Systemic fungicide when copper failed

Total spent: ₹600. Zero improvement both years.

4 DIAGNOSTIC QUESTIONS:

- ✓ Bumps appeared overnight, all leaves at once
- ✓ Pre-monsoon humidity 80–85%, 30–33°C nights
- ✓ Evening watering 6:30 PM throughout
- ✓ Growing tip completely smooth

**DIAGNOSIS:** Summer edema.

**PRESCRIPTION:** Shift to morning watering.

**COST:** ₹0.

**RESULT:** All new leaves smooth in 7 days ✓

*"Two seasons. Six hundred rupees. The only thing wrong was when I watered."*

## PRE-MONSOON PREVENTION CALENDAR

MARCH–EARLY APRIL: DRY SUMMER

Ruptured cell walls cannot be repaired by any product or condition change. The bump remains for the life of the leaf.


#### KEEP EVERY AFFECTED LEAF IF:

- ✓ Upper surface still green (photosynthesising normally)
- ✓ Plant still producing new growth or flowers
- ✓ No secondary fungal spread from bump sites

#### REMOVE ONLY IF:

- X Secondary brown/grey lesions spreading from bumps (uncommon in summer)
- X Upper surface yellowing covers more than 50%

#### JUDGE RECOVERY BY:

- ✓ Smooth clean new leaves at the growing tip  not by the condition of already-bumped leaves.

*Plant sheds most severely affected leaves naturally in 3–4 weeks. Do not accelerate.*

Standard evening watering acceptable. Start thermohygrometer monitoring habit. Check overnight humidity each morning from March 15th onward.

#### MID-APRIL THROUGH MAY: HIGHEST RISK ★★

At first 2 consecutive nights above 65%: shift to morning immediately. Inspect balsam undersides every 3 days — balsam shows before tomato/capsicum. Space containers, move away from walls.

#### JUNE: PRE-MONSOON BECOMING SUSTAINED

★★★

Humidity events become longer and more frequent. Morning watering mandatory. Reduce volume further. Don't return to evening until humidity consistently below 65% — often not until October.

#### ★ ACT BEFORE BUMPS, NOT AFTER

By the time bumps appear, the damaging overnight pressure event already occurred 24–48 hours earlier. Thermohygrometer monitoring lets you act on the trigger condition before visible damage forms.

## 🌿 SUMMER EDEMA FIX — PAGE 3: RECOVERY + PRODUCTS + SUNDAY CHECK

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Recovery Timeline • Products • 33-Item Cumulative Sunday Check

### RECOVERY AFTER MORNING WATERING SHIFT

Timeframe	Existing Bumps	New Growth
Day 0 — shifted	<b>Permanent, unchanged</b>	Check tip each morning
Day 3–5	<b>Unchanged</b>	New leaves emerging smooth
Day 7–10	<b>Unchanged</b>	All new growth clean
Day 14–21	<b>Still on old leaves</b>	Clean canopy established
Week 4–6	Oldest shedding naturally	New canopy fully clean

**WILL NOT RECOVER:** Corky bumps on existing leaves. Ruptured cell walls are permanent physical structures.

**WILL RECOVER:** All new leaves formed after schedule shift are completely smooth. Plant productivity, flowering, and fruiting completely unaffected by older leaf edema.

&#x26A;#x26A; EDEMA UNDERSIDE CHECK NEW D17 — Turn 3 leaves each: balsam, tomato, capsicum. Dry corky bumps + smooth new tip = summer edema. Shift to morning watering before 8 AM. Humidity above 65% for 2+ nights = morning-only mandatory.

&#x26A;#x26A; WATERING TIME + HUMIDITY LOG NEW D17 — Primary watering before 8 AM this week? Overnight humidity last 3 nights? Evening watering during humidity above 65% = edema risk active. Adjust schedule before next event.

33 checks. Under 37 minutes. Once a week.
